



After the Massacre of Innocent Children and Women in Gaza, Will the World Remain Silent against the Massacre of the People of Lebanon?

Certainly, all the Lebanese people, including the Lebanese Christians and their religious places, have been attacked, and it is not only the Lebanese Shia people who are fighting with the aggressor army. What is important is that the support of the people of the West for the innocent people of Gaza and Lebanon is completely different from their governments, and even the establishment of extreme right-wing governments in the West will not affect the people's attitude.
