A relatively new cardiology journal that started in 2006 is available to readers free of charge

The Journal of Tehran University Heart Center (JTUHC) is an international, English language, peer-reviewed medical journal, which has been published quarterly since 2006. The first three issues of this journal were printed under the title of The Journal of Tehran Heart Center and thereafter, the journal adopted the current title. The JTUHC is dedicated to the dissemination of clinical experience and research from around the world by publishing cardiovascular disease-related basic and clinical research in cardiology, cardiac surgery, cardiac anaesthesiology, cardiovascular epidemiology, paediatrics, genetics, rehabilitation, nutrition, pathology, radiology, nuclear medicine, etc. Different types of articles are published such as original, editorial, case reports, reviews, systematic reviews, meta-analysis, brief communications, and letters to the editor. Additionally, the Photo Clinic section publishes scintillation images from various cardiovascular fields.

What considerably enhances the scientific cache of the JTUHC is its pursuit of publishing highly qualified papers in its Editorial Board, comprised of many highly regarded scientists both internationally and domestically, and an Advisory Board, composed of scientists with considerable experience in scientific writing.

The JTUHC recruits peer reviewers from among distinguished Iranian and foreign scientists to fulfil the internationally accepted standards of quality and validity. Our journal also benefits from the expertise of several biostatisticians in the review of received manuscripts. At the first stage, each manuscript is reviewed by a biostatistician. If the method of analysis or reporting of research results in a manuscript is disapproved by the biostatistician, the review process will be discontinued; otherwise, the manuscript will be referred to at least three other peer reviewers. A manuscript is eligible for publication if two-thirds of these reviewers accept the manuscript and deem it publishable. All submission and review processes are on-line, and all the contents are open access. The JTUHC does not charge authors for the publication of their papers nor does it charge the readers of the published papers. Therefore, this journal is totally free of charge. The journal is a member of the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE) and adheres to COPE's fowcharts and guidelines vis-à-vis ethical misconduct.

The JTUHC is proud to have already published several papers from around the globe. From 2006 until the end of 2017, we published papers from authors of 28 countries aside from Iran—with American and Turkish authors topping the list. Our journal has been indexed in several databases including PubMed, PubMed Central, Scopus, EMBASE, CAB Abstracts, Global Health, Chemical Abstracts Service, CINAHL, ProQuest, Google Scholar, Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ), EBSCO, Geneva Foundation for Medical Education and Research, Index Copernicus, Index Medicus for the WHO Eastern

Mediterranean Region (EMEMR), ISC, SID, IranMedex, Magiran, Academic Keys, Cite Factor (Directory Indexing of International Research Journal), CSA, DRIJ, Electronic Journals Library, Google Scholar Metrics, LocationPlus, Ulrichsweb Global Serials Directory, Universal Impact Factor, and WorldCat. Additionally, the JTUHC is currently under consideration for indexing by Web of Science (ISI).

We, at the JTUHC, are very optimistic about the future and firmly believe that the helping hands of our colleagues from around the world will enable us to attain our lofty goals. We eagerly look forward to receiving high-quality papers from authors the world over (<http://jthc.tums.ac.ir>) and warmly welcome volunteer peer reviewers also.
